Police Meets with CPO on Job Evaluation Exercise

February 28, 2023 - The Trinidad and Tobago Police Service Social and Welfare Association (TTPSWA) representing the 1st and 2nd Divisions met with the Chief Personnel Officer (CPO), Commander Dr. Daryl Dindial to commence preliminary discussions on a new Job Evaluation Exercise for Offices within the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service (TTPS) at the Office of the CPO, earlier today.

Some of the issues that were discussed in the meeting covered the potential **Job Evaluation** methodologies, timelines, governance structures, and composition of the **Job Evaluation Committees** and the requisite next steps for the Cabinet's consideration.

Commander Dindial recognises the impact a new **Job Evaluation Exercise** can have on the **TTPS**' **Compensation and Classification Structure.** He added that the **Job Evaluation Exercise** will update the competency profile of all jobs and it will consequently impact human resource functions such as training and development, recruitment and selection and performance management.

The current TTPS Classification and Compensation system was an outcome of a successfully completed Job Evaluation Exercise between the CPO and the Association in the early 2000s. In that exercise, a new grade structure was completed along with recommendations arising from a salary survey. The CPO advises that there are one hundred and eighty-eight (188) positions within an establishment of approximately seven thousand, eight hundred and eighty-four (7,884) Officers that will be subject to the Job Evaluation Exercise.

Following the meeting, **Dr. Dindial** expressed his commitment to working collaboratively with the **Association** and the **Ministry of National Security** throughout the exercise. He further stated that the **Personnel Department** learnt valuable lessons in the leadership, management, and administration of previous **Job Evaluation Exercises** and is well-equipped to complete this exercise within the timelines, from its commencement.

Further to the recent completion of negotiations with the **CPO**, the President of the **TTPSWA**, ASP **Gideon Dickson** sees the advancement of the **TTPS' Job Evaluation Exercise** as critical and the **Association** and its members look forward to the development of the process. He added, twenty years have elapsed since the last exercise and the offices in the **TTPS** deserve to be evaluated in line with international best practices.

The exercise is expected to commence in January 2024.
